Optional:

Fishing vest	Camera	Wading Boots
Tackle box (small)	Fishing rod & reel	

For our fishing excursions, Camp Cavell will supply each camper with all necessary fishing gear (rods, reels, tackle, flies, etc) and group camping equipment, canoes, kayaks, life jackets.

For kids going on the UP NORTH TRIP, we will do our best to supply waders and wading boots. We have *most* sizes but just in case, **bring an old pair of gym shoes or hard soled water sandals** that strap on and can be worn in the river or lake (beach type water shoes are NOT safe for fishing).
