Campers Stay in Cabins!



Each cabin holds seven to nine campers and one counselor. Cabins have electricity and heat with bathrooms & showers nearby.

Cots have four inch foam mattresses and campers bring sleeping bags or bedding. Cabin placement is by age/grade and gender.

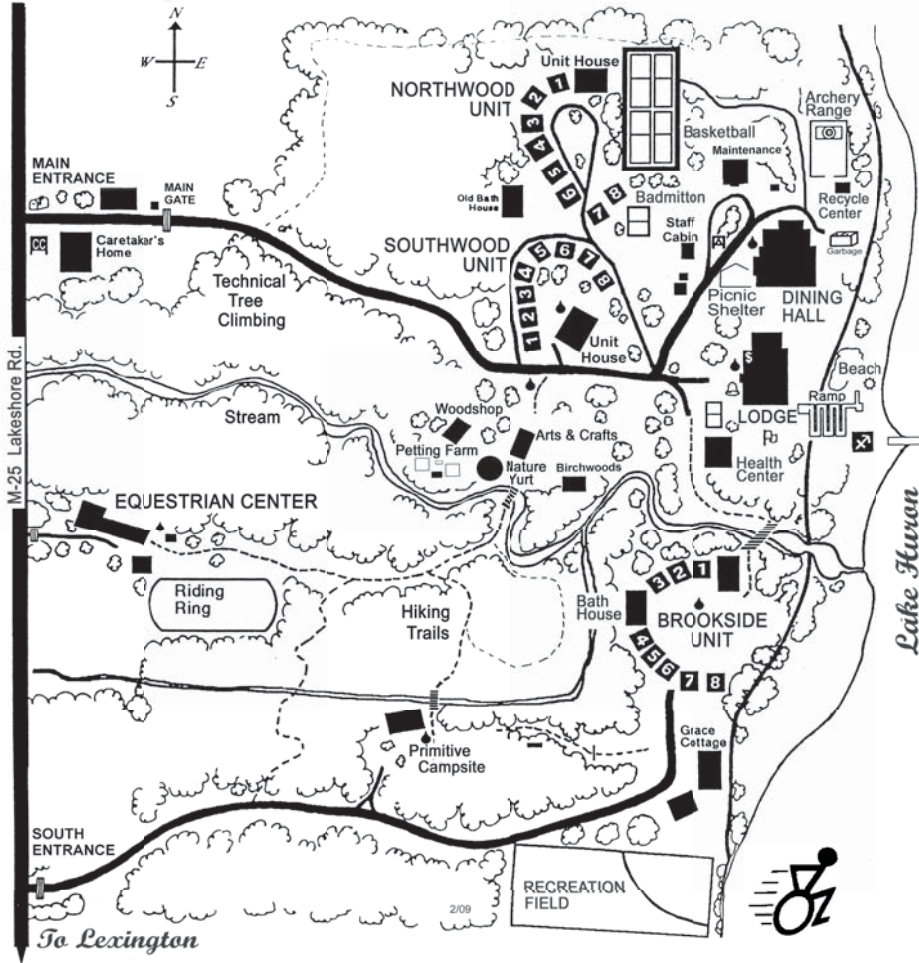


Leadership, Equestrian, or Counselor in Training

Three programs for older girls to help them gain experience in leadership, teamwork, and problem solving. Learn the skills needed to work with children. See our website for more information and an application!

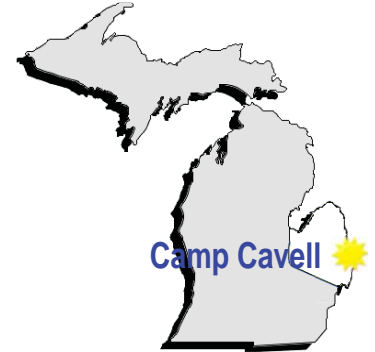


Camp Cavell
